Comments of the Office of Registrar General, India on the proposal of Himachal Pradesh Government for inclusion of 'Hattee' community of entire Trans-Giri area of Sirmour district and permanent residents of Dodra-Kwar sub-division and 15/20 area of Shimla and Kullu districts in the list of Scheduled Tribes

The above stated proposal of the State Government of Himachal Pradesh is the second reference along with a supporting Report prepared by the Tribal Research Institute of the State. Earlier in 2005, the proposal was for inclusion of 'Hattu' (Girpari) and 'Dudra-Kwaru' communities in the list of Scheduled Tribes of Himachal Pradesh. The proposal could not be considered favourably by the Office of the Registrar General India (ORGI) vide d o no. 371/2005-SS (H P) dated 3/10/2006. The proposal has been again examined as per extant criteria and modalities taking into account the information furnished by the State Government. The details are as follows:

Earlier Reference:

The proposal was examined twice earlier in the years 1995 and in 2006. Views of this office on the said proposal was that 'Hattee' and 'Dudra-Kwaru' communities are not homogeneous groups. 'Hattee' and 'Dudra-Kwaru' are traditional, blanket of generic terms applicable to a number of individual castes; these do not refer to a tribe or tribal community or part of or group within a tribe. Inclusion of territorial names and functional names not specifying any ethnic group is not being considered now for inclusion in the list of SCs/STs until or unless they stand for any specific ethnic group. There is a similarity in the position of 'Jainsari' of Jainsar Bawar and those of 'Girpar' region, but declaring a geographical area as a Scheduled Area or the inhabitants of that area as a Scheduled Tribe using a blanket term to cover all the characteristics, whether deserving Scheduled Tribe status or possessing tribal characteristics or not is against the principle of notification or declaring them as STs. Most of the castes reported under the term 'Hattee' and 'Dudra-Kwaru' (namely, Koli, Dhaki, Doom, Chana, Badhi, Lohar etc.) are enjoying the status of Scheduled Castes in the state at present. It indicates that these castes (not tribes) suffer from socio-economic and educational backwardness arising out of the historical custom of untouchability. This office is not in favour of inclusion of blanket/generic term or territorial name representing more than one caste/tribe in the STs list, as it is against the provision of Article 342(2) of the constitution.

Justification furnished by the State Government:

A. Hattee Community:

In response to the above comments of ORGI the State Government has furnished a Report in support of the said proposal prepared by the Institute of Tribal Studies, Shimla. The Report recommends that entire 'Hattee' community living in entire Trans-Giri area of Sirmour district, Himachal Pradesh may be notified as Scheduled Tribe because the entire 'Hattee' community shares the same tribal traits, culture in geographical isolation etc. as noticed among the Scheduled Tribes of the State. In addition to 'Hattee' community the permanent residents living in Dodra-Kwar sub-division of Shimla district and 15/20 area of Shimla and Kullu districts also have

and Kullu Districts as Scheduled Areas. The background of the matter is that the Tribal Development Department had earlier vide its letter No.PLG.F(TDM)10-2/98 dated 04.05.2005 had submitted a proposal to the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt to declare the following areas as Scheduled Areas and the people living therein as Scheduled Tribes :

A. Proposal for Declaring Scheduled Areas:

1. Chhota and Bara Bangal of Kangra District.
2. Trans Giri Area of Sirmour District
3. Chohar Valley of Mandi District.
4. Sub-Division Dodra-Kwar, Tehsil Chirgoan and Remote area of Tehsil Rampur Bushahr.
5. Sub-Division Churah of Chamba District, and
6. 15/20 Area and Malana Area of Kullu District.

B. Proposal for Declaring Certain Communities as Scheduled Tribe:

1. Barad Community
2. Bangala Community
3. Labana Community
4. Hattee Community, and
5. Dudra Kawaru Community.

Subject: Regarding Declaration of "Hattie" Tribes as Scheduled Tribes in Giripar Area of District Sirsaour, N.P. Himachal Pradesh

Sir,

Kindly refer to your letter no. 780/E/1-1/2020 dated 13.9.2020 on the subject cited above.

At first, the 'Hattie' people are demanding declaration of all castes belonging to their community (Detailed hereinafter) as Scheduled Tribes and thereafter, on basis of overwhelming majority (above 95%) of these castes in the total population, declaration of Giripar Area of District Sirsaour as Scheduled Tribe area for the last more than 25 years. This office has made available from time to time all figures and facts as desired by the Socy.Welfare / Director Welfare, Govt. of H.P. Shimla above justification and genuineness of this demand.

The necessary consents /proposals in this connection are as under:-

1. Community, Area and Population

The group of castes proposed to be declared as Scheduled Tribes is commonly known as 'Hattie' and the area inhabited by them is Giripar of district Sirsaour N.P., consisting of tehsils Shillai, Benoka Ji, and Rajgarh, Sub-Tehsils Kasruo, Mushat and Nohra and all the panchayats of tehsil Paonta Sahib falling in Shillai assembly constituency. The details of the names of proposed castes, area and population are as under:-

performer of Hatt, they were called 'Hattas'. Due to their extreme backwardness, poverty, these half-caste unclean figures the terms 'Hates' assumed derogatory connotation.

2. Does Hatt cover many castes/Tribes of district ethnic affiliations or does it stand for a simple ethnic group.

The term 'Hates' is used for all castes/ethnic groups: Khosh, Koli, Bhat, Dhaki, Baroyas, D Doon, Lohar, Chahal, Chamar, Daity and Toori residing for generation to generation in the Giripar area. Most of these castes are declared Scheduled castes in Himachal Pradesh.

3. Does Hatt possess district tribal characteristics? If Hatt stands for different ethnic groups, then which are they and how many of these possess tribal characteristics:-
- विशेषताएं

The Hattas possess the district-tribal characteristics like peculiar social and culture customs and tradition quite different from the main stream. The practices of polyandry, child-marriages, socio-magical religious practices, right of inheritance different from the Hindu-laws, typical dialect, food habits, dresses, fairs and festivals akin to that of adjoining Scheduled Tribes area 'Januseri-Babar' of Uttar Pradesh, which was once a part of the erstwhile Sirmour Riyasat.

विशेषता

In the light of the above facts it is requested that the 'Giripar Area' be declared as a Scheduled area as the Januseri Babar area of Uttar Pradesh is already declared as Scheduled Tribal Area, which is adjoining area of Giripar area of district Sirmour in Himachal Pradesh.

2. This proposal was returned by the Central Government vide letter No.12016/19/2001-TA(RL)/C&LM-1 dated 15.06.2006 with certain observations more particularly to provide sociological and ethnographic evidence. The State Government vide letter No.TBD.A(TDM)4-8/2008 dated 27.08.2011 had assigned this study to Tribal Research Institute, H.P. University to prepare a proposal to declare these areas as Scheduled Areas and inhabitant of these areas as Scheduled Tribes. However, a deputation of people from Sirmour District had met Hon'ble Chief Minister in May, 2016 and submitted a representation that since the survey of Trans-Giri area is complete, therefore, the proposal for notifying this area as Tribal Area and its people as STs be forwarded to Government of India. On this, Hon'ble Chief Minister has desired to submit the report within 20 days as conveyed to the Tribal Development Department vide Hon'ble Chief Minister U.O. No.Secy/CM-07102/2012-VIP-A-342225 dated 28.05.2016. Accordingly, the department vide letter TBD-A(TDM)4-8/2008-II dated 31.05.2016 requested Director, TRI, H.P. University to submit the report as desired by the Hon'ble C.M.
